Kaleidoskop – Open Air Film Festival

Kaleidoskop is an open air film festival of diverse urban identities. Since 2019 the festival is a free annual event of three weeks taking place at Karlsplatz in Vienna; it is organized and curated by CineCollective“ (Djamila Grandits, Marie-Christine Hartig, Lisa Mai and Doris Posch). 13.500 people participated in the first edition of Kaleidoskop in 2019.

The curatorial focus lies on shared life, collective living and working in urban spaces and the cultural, architectural, socio-political development connected to it. Kaleidoskop highlights the social dynamics of political and economic conflicts, manifestations of religious and cultural world views as well as questions of belonging.

Kaleidoskop celebrates the recognition of gender equality and cultural diversity while working specifically and with discernment, not to generalize but to refer to specific positions, to involve diverse groups of the population explicitly, to convey a diverse image of our society. Kaleidoskop is standing up against social division and is inviting new perspectives.

The film program features a wide array of topics and transcends formal boundaries with special emphasis on free and open access, involving also diversity of language and barrier-free access. Film and art education is an integral part of the program. Curatorial intros involving artistic and participatory interventions by Vienna-based artists, performers, activists and organizations mark the beginning of each film screening. The main concern here is to create a lively dialogue of the film narrative with vivid local structures to make the festival an immersive experience.

The fellowship has 2 periods. April to July and September to October 2020.

The fellowship is offering the opportunity to co-create the film introduction programs of the open air film festival Kaleidoskop 2020 in the function of curatorial project assistant. This will specifically imply the cooperation with CineCollective in the curation of the 22 intro formats as well as the assistance of performers in the realisation of their work and organisational tasks concerning the events June 26th to July 17th 2020.

Kaleidoskop's intros are autonomous artistic formats introducing the presented films and highlighting specific aspects of them. They make use of a broad spectrum of artistic forms such as: Performance, concert, lecture, spoken word poetry, participatory dialogue, socio-political and film discussion ... everything is possible. The intros will be realised by (currently) Vienna-based artists, performers and activists.

Aside from the intros there will be a possibility to work in other areas of the Kaleidoskop festival 2020 such as work with target groups, PR, social media, project organisation and documentation.

There are further plans for film presentations in September and October 2020.

We wish for artistic and conceptual cooperation. This call is addressed to artists and mediators/curators as well as persons working at the interstices of both areas. The other criterium though is, in accordance with the intentions of kultür gemma! the self-definition as a migrant.

Qualifications

- Experience with artistic and mediatorial/curatorial work and/or cultural management.
- Residence in Vienna.
- Language skills: English (required), German (desirable).
- Experience in autonomous work and a private laptop.

Application possible in German and English.

Documents of application

The following documents are mandatory:

- Letter of Motivation (1 A4-page max.)
- Free-form CV/biography (2 A4-pages max.)

Deadline

Applications are due March 18th 2020.

The Fellowship starts beginning/mid April 2020.

Interviews will be held end of March.
The fellow will be selected by CineCollective in cooperation with kültür gemma!
